

Luke 15

For the son of man came to seek and save the lost. Luke 19:10

Charles Dickens and Ralph Waldo Emerson both said that the Parable of the Prodigal Son was the 'greatest short story ever written'.

A Parable in Scripture something "cast alongside" something else. Jesus' parables were stories that were "cast alongside" a truth in order to illustrate that truth.
