

From sea to shining sea**









The Fruit of the Fall

Genesis 4-5

Taking the ‘forbidden fruit’ must have seemed trivial to Adam and Eve. They had chosen to believe Satan and rebel against God’s ‘harsh and unreasonable’ rule. (4:1)

Reality is Always Real

“I got him from the Lord” (4:1)

But then...

Cain killed his brother. (4:6-7)

God declared a curse on Cain. (4:12)

**My punishment is harsh and unfair.
(4:13-14)**

The Battle is Also Real

“Cain left the presence of the Lord” (4:16)

**“Then men began to call on the name of the Lord”
(4:26)**

“And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.” (Gen. 3:15)

“Two kinds of people were on the earth...descendants of Cain and descendants of Seth.

One group lived for this world, the other lived for the world to come.”

The World That Cain Built:

- **Socially permissive.** (4:19)
- **Scientifically progressive.** (4:17-22)
- **Spiritually deceived** (6:11-12)

**To describe Cain's line, God tells
us of cities, culture, agriculture
and industry (4:21-22)**

**For Seth's line , God tells us that they
lived...and they died (5:1-24) .**

**While noting the accomplishments of
the Cainites, He does not say that
they lived or that they died.**

They merely existed!

Judgement is Always Certain

“My Spirit will not always abide with man...” (6:3)

Lamech the 7th from Adam.

“took 2 wives...killed a man...”

Enoch the 7th from Adam.

“walked with God...took him.”
