





Youth and the Yoke

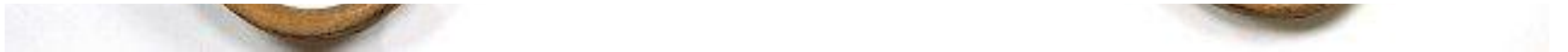

Researchers describe childhood as a life stage when people are most open to the Gospel.

Once a person reaches adulthood, accepting Christ becomes increasingly rare.

This has led to a missiological focus on children aged 4 to 14. If you desire to win a people group to Christ, begin with the children.

Reasons Today's Kids Are Bored, Entitled, Impatient with Few Real Friends

Clearly, throughout my time as an Occupational Therapist, I have seen and continue to see a decline in children's social, emotional, and academic functioning, as well as a sharp increase in learning disabilities and other diagnoses. Their brains are getting used to the high levels of stimulation that modern technology provides. The inability to process lower levels of stimulation often leaves kids vulnerable to academic challenges. They also tend to disconnect us emotionally from our children and our families. (Victoria Prooday, OT)

1. Kids get what they want when they want it.

We have the best intentions — to make our child happy — but unfortunately, we make them happy at the moment but potentially miserable in the long term. To be able to delay gratification means to be able to function under stress. Our children are gradually becoming less equipped to deal with even minor stressors, which eventually become huge obstacles to their success in life.

2. Endless fun

We have created an artificial fun world for our children. When things become quiet, we run to entertain them again, because otherwise, we feel that we are not doing our parenting duty. We live in two separate worlds. They have their “fun” world, and we have our “work” world. Why aren’t children helping us in the kitchen or with laundry? Why don’t they tidy up their toys? This is basic monotonous work that trains the brain to be workable and function under “boredom,” which is the same “muscle” that is required to be eventually teachable at school

3. Kids rule the world

“My child doesn’t like vegetables.” “She doesn’t like going to bed early.” “He doesn’t like to eat breakfast.” “She doesn’t like toys, but she is very good at her iPad”

If we leave it all up to them, all they are going to do is eat macaroni and cheese, watch TV, play on their tablets, and never go to bed.

What good are we doing them by giving them what they WANT when we know that it is not GOOD for them? Without proper nutrition and a good night’s sleep, our kids come to school irritable, anxious, and inattentive.

In addition, we send them the wrong message. They learn they can do what they want and not have to do what they don’t want.
