#### The Subtlety of Satan's Compromise

Exodus 8-10

# In Biblical typology, Egypt is a type of the world and Pharaoh is a type of Satan.

# Subtle - so delicate or precise as to be difficult to analyze or describe.

### Serve the Lord, but Stay in Egypt

"Sacrifice to Your God in the Land of Egypt." (Ex. 8:25)

The world will never understand the worship of a Bible Christian. "The cross is foolishness to them that are perishing..."

# "Go...but not very far away." Exodus 8:28

# Sure, you're a Christian but don't be a fanatic.



Pulpits are silent, parents look the other way and there is little difference between Christians and the world.

#### Go, but leave your families in Egypt

**Exodus 10:10-11** 

"The LORD had better be with you when I let you and your little ones go! Beware, for evil is ahead of you. Not so! Go now, you who are men, and serve the LORD, for that is what you desired." (Exodus 10:10-11)

Stastics show that children today spend an average of 30 hours per week in school where they are often taught ideas that are diametrically opposed to biblical truth...evolution, the acceptance of homosexuality, etc.

Then they come home to spend another 30 hours per week watching television, playing video games, or connecting on social media.

The key factor in keeping young people from falling away from their faith continues to be the influence of their parents. Studies have consistently found that when parents were active in church and faithful to biblical principle, their children were much more likely to remain faithful to The Faith.

A Fuller Seminary study determined that the most important factor in whether young people leave the church or remain steadfast in their faith is whether they have a safe haven to express their doubts and concerns regarding their faith before leaving home. Such a refuge is found in two places: their home and their church youth group.

Churches must take a hard look at youth programs. Instead of emphasizing entertainment, we need to teach Scripture with logic, truth, and a Christian worldview. Frank Turek, a lecturer on apologetics, says this about the problem: "What we win them with we win them to. If we win them with entertainment and low commitment, we win them to entertainment and low commitment."

Charles Spurgeon was way ahead of his time when he implored the church of his day to 'start feeding the sheep rather than amusing the goats'.

### Go, but leave your money.

**Exodus 10:24** 

Then Pharaoh called to Moses and said, "Go, serve the LORD; only let your flocks and your herds be kept back." (Ex. 10:24)
