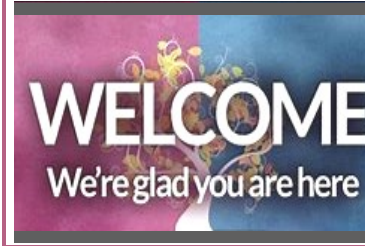

Their relationship was one that many older men try to model with the younger men in their lives. As Paul neared his death, he felt it necessary to speak comforting words to his young son in the faith.
