

The Tree Who Stood Alone... Not long ago, just down from our church building, a property was cleared of nearly every tree. There was one tree left. Standing at over 60 feet tall, this tree would stand tall and proud in this recent development against the backdrop of a new house. Then it happened. A storm came. The rain fell. The wind blew. The now single tree, standing proud by itself in the cleared field, fell down. As trees grow, the storms that come make them stronger as the tree bends in the wind and then hardens under the stress a storm brings about. Life is much like a storm to a tree. A tree can stand alone, and many do. But the tree is most likely to grow healthy and not fall over when with other trees. The God Who created the trees is the same God who created humankind. He designed us to need spiritual, social, and physical interaction. We find the community we need in the Church. Christians need to be with their church to grow, develop in healthy ways, and to help when storms come. Christian, we need each other. The storms of life may be increasing, but God is greater!
